## What's New?

DeliverHealth is pleased to announce the release of InScribe v7.10. This release includes the following bug fixes.

## Solved Issues

- Fixed an issue that was preventing users from toggling between Insert and Overwrite while editing.
- Updated the InScribe dictionary with two changes:
  - o corrected the spelling of the word 'triglycerides'.
  - o changed the correct case of the word 'takotsubo' to lowercase.
- MT Notes are now being displayed when an MT changes the document type, dictator, or location, and the 'Keep Text' option has been selected. Also, the option to show 'MT Notes' is no longer grayed out.



- When a dictation template ('normal') is inserted, and an MT Note is attached, the focus will be in the MT Note (not the editor), allowing the user to close the note using the enter key.
- When an MT reviews their graded feedback, the QA Version tab now shows the altered text in blue highlight (when "show changes" is unchecked). Previously, no text was highlighted.
- Removed the IE version from the 'About InScribe' window.
