What's New?

DeliverHealth is pleased to announce the release of InQuery updates, including changes to the Search All screens and minor enhancements and bug fixes.

Search All

- The data grid and controls load and can be configured prior to submitting a search.
- Submitted search criteria are displayed below the Search filter box and “Contains” filters appear in the Search filter box.
- Clinician names are listed and searchable in Last Name, First Name format.
- Transcription ID and Receipt have been added to the Search All – Invalidated Advanced Search window.
